# Alta Pinakothek in Munich

### Construction measure

### Type of object

- Historically protected / historically valuable buildings

### Brief description

Constructed by Leo von Klenze during the period of 1826 – 1836, the Alte Pinakothek in Munich was heavily damaged in World War II; only the exterior walls remained standing. It was reconstructed in 1957 and the gallery it had contained, which had been relocated, was returned.
