Brief description

The Olympic Stadium Munich was the central sport facility in the Olympic Park and the main venue for the Olympic Summer Games 1972. After the Olympic Games, mainly national and international soccer games as well as light athletic events were held in the Olympic Stadium. The Olympic sport facilities from 1972 did not leave an enormous dead inventory sport site behind but a naturally (designed) landscape with a sport architecture still well utilised. The ensemble is one of Munich's landmarks.
