

- Reduction of gloss

- Structural defects
- Damage due to greater or unsuitable utilisation or loads not intended when the offer was made

- Damage that has occurred because regular care and maintenance were not properly carried out

When the building is completed or final cleaning has been carried out, the windows and doors must be examined for damage and, if there are any defects, professionally repaired. The products recommended by the system supplier are to be used for the repairs.

All at a Glance – the Fast-Finder

Time	Measure
1. Directly after mounting, during the construction phase	Masking with suitable adhesive tape. Windows tipped.
2. After the construction phase	Check windows for damage caused by workers.
3. In case of light damage to varnished surfaces	Treat with Induline Touch-Up Varnish .
4. At the earliest after 6–8 weeks	Clean for the first time with a mild cleaning agent. Use of Induline Wood Care Balsam .
5. Maintenance measures in 6 month intervals, for protected constructions, e.g. wood/aluminium windows, every 2 years	Use of Induline Wood Care Balsam .
6. After each following year	Complete check of windows. Remedy damage with Induline Touch-Up Varnish . Use of Induline Wood Care Balsam .

This guide will provide information on how to keep your wood windows and doors functional for the maximum amount of time with just a minimum of effort.

Allow yourself the joy of wood

You've made the right decision. Wood has a number of advantages. As a renewable resource, it's the ideal building material for windows and doors. As a natural building material it has outstanding properties: wood has a positive effect on the climate in the room, it "breathes", helps to harmonise the moisture balance and it has thermal as well as sound insulating properties. Wood is naturally beautiful and practically nothing can compare with it.

Just a little attention to your wood windows

The building material wood, excel-



lent workmanship by the producer of your windows and the high quality treatment of the surfaces with the Remmers **Induline** System not only guarantee that these windows will remain functional for a long time but also that the natural beauty of the wood will be permanently maintained as well. Even the best building material needs a minimum of attention. If you read the tips and notes in this flyer and then follow these instructions, your precious "facade furniture" will give you years of pleasure.

The beginning

When your windows are transported and then installed, this is painstakingly done by experienced people. But other construction activities that go on can easily damage the surfaces. If you should discover any defects on your windows, notify the person who sold them to you immediately.

This will ensure that any damage is professionally repaired right away so that function and beauty are maintained and your windows will be a joy.

Superficial damage can be repaired quickly and easily with **Induline Touch-Up Varnish**. It comes in the same shade of colour that your windows have.

Protection right from the beginning

Right from the beginning during the construction phase, it's recommended to cover coated windows with a suitable material.

If you use adhesive tape to cover and protect the windows, make sure the tape is UV-resistant so that it does not fuse to the surface of the window in sunlight. Once that happens, it's practically impossible to remove the tape without damaging the coating. Ask a professional what kind of masking tape should be used for this purpose.

Air, air and air again

Your wood windows are a dry affair. To make sure they stay that way, high moisture loads, especially in the construction phase, caused by water evaporating out of render, screed or from painting and wall paper work should be avoided. The only thing that really helps is sufficient airing.

Take your time

Freshly coated surfaces should only be cleaned after 6-8 weeks at the earliest. Avoid intensive, dry rubbing and aggressive cleaning agents. Use only mild, commercially available cleaners. While you're at it, check the windows for damage that might have been caused by workers and, if necessary, repair with **Induline Touch-Up Varnish**.

The signs of time

During the course of time, wind and weather "gnaw" on our buildings. To increase the service life and durability of modern window constructions, please use **Induline Wood Care Balsam**. It is applied after the windows are cleaned with a soft, non-fraying rag just like furniture polish and then wiped off - and right away the surface shines again like new.

At the same time, the substrate becomes dirt and water repelling,

similar to a coat of wax on car varnish. By using the balsam just twice a year, you can refresh protection and maintain the beauty of your wood windows and doors for 10 years and even more.

Fresh air is healthy

Windows often mist up. When many people are in a room together, for example, a lot of moisture is given off (per night and person approx. 1 litre). This can have unpleasant consequences such as the growth of mildew in the corners of rooms or on ceilings, walls, window gaskets or behind furniture. Over the long-term, mildew and mould damage the building substance and are often the cause for health problems.

Proper airing

The right way to air is to air intensively. All rooms should be aired for 10-15 minutes mornings and, when used, for 5 minutes 3-4 times during the day. Turn off the heating and open windows wide. This is more effective than having slightly opened windows all the time and also saves energy. Since the oxygen-rich, dry air from the outside warms more quickly than damp, your heating system will have things comfortable more quickly.

Window check

Once a year, take a very close look at your windows. Check gaskets, sealants and the surfaces. And while you're at it, you can also grease any hinges and moveable parts, adjusting them if necessary.

The time has come

No surface will hold up forever. However, the measures described here will help you keep your wood windows and doors attractive for a very long time.

One stop shopping

With the **Induline Care Set** you have all of the products you need to protect and care for your windows and doors: Wood Care Balsam, V-Joint Protection and, if necessary, **Induline Touch-Up Varnish**.

Something worth paying attention to!

A thick layer stain not only maintains the natural texture of your wood windows, it even lets the wood look more brilliant than it would if it were not treated. However, over the long term, bleaching, a loss of gloss and changes in the colour caused by weather can't always be avoided even if they have been cared for properly - something that applies to opaque coatings just as well. Immediately after they are applied, window varnishes may lose pigments - and this is particularly not unusual for highly pigmented, silk gloss coatings.

The reason for this is a certain excess of coloured particles that are not completely bound into the binder.

However, the release of pigments has no influence on the colour or weather resistance. On the other hand, mechanical damage caused, e.g. by hail, can have a negative effect, also on opaque coatings. This is the reason the recommended intervals for care and maintenance should be observed. Your windows will thank you for this!

Conditions for the guarantee

The performance of the system supplier including sequential damage is limited to max. 40,000.00.

The guarantee given by the system supplier assumes that

- the windows were installed taking the VFF Code of Practice

H0.01 - classification of coatings for wood windows and house doors into consideration

- there were no violations of the obligation to supervise construction and there were no planning errors

- the guarantee registration form found in the Care Set was completely filled out by the customer, signed and returned to Remmers Baustofftechnik GmbH
- the delivered goods were paid in full.

A guarantee beyond the scope of the statutory guarantee will only be given by the system supplier if the windows and doors have been maintained according to Remmers Guide for Preserving the Value of Your Wood Windows and Wood Doors.

The guarantee does not apply if:

- there is mechanical damage that does not correspond to normal use
 - mechanical damage has been caused by weather, e.g. hail, the effects of storms, etc.
 - damage was caused by work subsequently carried out
- Changes of the coating that are deemed normal aging will not be accepted as a reason for complaint:
- Change in the shade of colour of the coating
 - Changes in the colour of the coating due to a darkening of the wood
