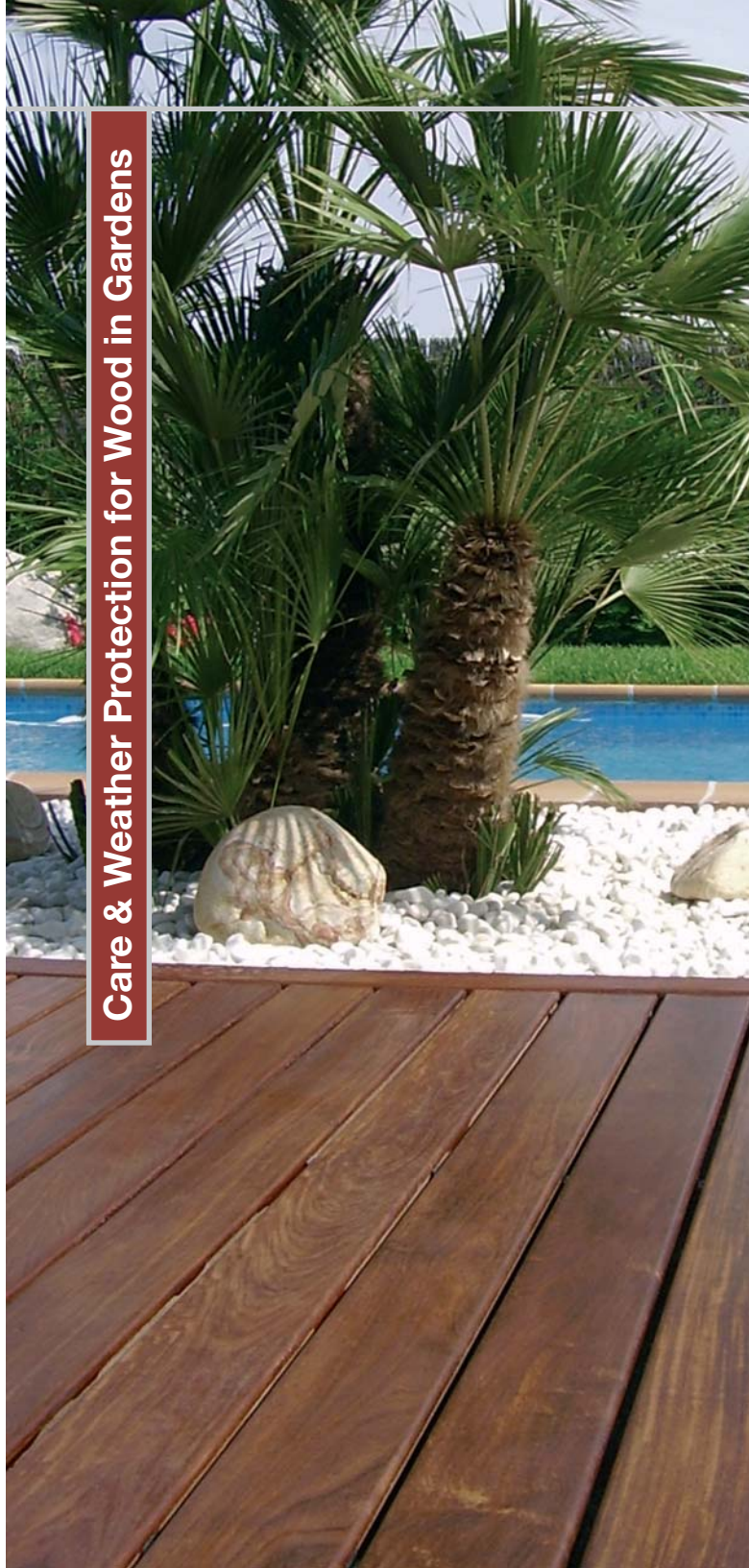

Properties

- Especially long-term protection against weather & turning grey
- High UV-protection
- Contains a preservative to protect the film from green growth
- Water based – no annoying odours
- Dries quickly: 2 coats can be applied in one day

Tips & Information:

- Aidol Garden Wood Oils may be intermixed but should not be mixed with other oils (e.g. Aidol Maintenance Oil)!
- Prime soft wood as well as all other species sensitive to fungi in outdoor areas with a wood preservative (e.g. Aidol Primer/Blue Stain Inhibitor).
- Stir contents well before using, also during work and after pauses.
- Coat end grain surfaces generously 2x with Aidol Garden Wood Oil to protect the surfaces from the absorption of moisture.
- Apply 2 thin coats of undiluted oil in the direction of the grain with an acrylic brush suitable for water based products.
- When Aidol Universal Oil (clear) is used, renovation intervals are shorter than for pigmented versions. Soft wood should be coated 3x!
- New boards for wood decks should be treated on both sides, if possible.
- Garden furniture & wood decks made of high quality hardwood should be allowed to dry very thoroughly before using.

Range of use

- For long-term protection of wood in gardens
- For wood decks and garden furniture
- Colours coordinated to the species teak, bangkirai, larch and Douglas fir
- Also for many other species of wood, e.g. Massaranduba, Iroko, oak, Australian blackwood, kapur, thermally treated and acetylated wood

Container sizes:

- 0.75 l
- 2.5 l

Application rate:

- Hardwood: 1st coat: 60 - 80 ml/m²
2nd coat: 40 - 60 ml/m²
- Soft wood: 1st coat: 80 - 100 ml/m²
2nd coat: 60 - 80 ml/m²

Notes on the application rate:

Do not exceed the given application rates (max. two coats).
Aidol Universal Oil (clear): We recommend 3 coats for soft wood
