Hotel Ellington in Berlin, Germany

Construction measures

- Floor coating – decorative systems

Type of object

- Hotels

Brief description

Originally designed as an administration building, it was known during the "golden 20's" to the people of Berlin as the "Femina" amusement centre. During the 70's it again attracted people who wanted to dance in the Nürnberger Street as a discothèque called "Dschungel" but after that it went down hill. After standing empty for 10 years, the Berlin architects and interior architects Reuter Schoger were commissioned to completely overhaul the building. The historically protected building with its approx. 20,000 m² floor space is now Hotel Ellington with 285 rooms, six conference rooms, a restaurant and eight other stores. The Femina ballroom which had been destroyed during the war was made into a breakfast room and a 600 m² conference and banquet hall was placed on the top floor. Visitors are impressed by the subdued rooms that are kept in pure white and the Remmers PUR floor coating has a lot to do with this.

Product systems used / Size

Floor coating – decorative systems

Poured asphalt: primed with Remmers PUR InduColor
Flow coating with 2.2 kg/m² Remmers PUR InduColor, RAL 9002
Sealant: Remmers PUR Color Top M, RAL 9002
Within the course of a year, a total area of 1,100 m² were coated in sections of 300-400 m², depending on the progress of the construction measures.
