Brief description

This representative building was constructed during the twenties by Karl Bosch, Nobel Prize winner and the developer of ammonia synthesis. The mansion can look back on a lively past: emergency shelter during the war, alternative accommodations for the BASF plants, accommodations for the occupying US forces and the South German Radio Station. Attention was also drawn to the Bosch mansion when it served as the backdrop for a television series on the legendary Peter Belheim, the owner of a large department store chain. After restoration, the Klaus Tschita Foundation, the Cross Cultural Leadership Forum and the European Media Lab set up their offices here.
