

Chadderton Police Station Oldham, Lancashire



Tornado Management Limited, have recently completed the application of high performance specialist floor and wall coatings, to the custody and secure areas of the new Chadderton Police Station in Oldham, for the Greater Manchester Police Authority.

The floors were screeded with Remmers Floormix solvent free epoxy flooring system, to give a smooth dense, 'pick proof' and easily cleaned, hygienic surface. This was laid to falls out from the cells to stainless steel gullies in the corridors which are also bedded and sealed with Remmers epoxy resins.

The floor was coved at the wall junctions with the same resin material, producing a curved and seamless connection to the high gloss and equally easily cleaned and 'pick-proof' Remmers epoxy wall coating system. This was produced using Remmers

BS 2000 and BS3000 coloured, water based epoxy resins.

The strict and detailed design specifications and performance requirements were produced by consultants McBains Cooper and the main contractor for the project, Laing O'Rourke as part of their framework agreement with the Greater Manchester Police Authority.

This project clearly demonstrates the successful combination of Remmers advanced systems, with Tornado's skills and management competence, in this specialist field with strict regulations and security procedures.

This latest project brings the total number of cells built or upgraded by Tornado, with these advanced Remmers coating systems, to more than 200 at eleven police stations for the GMPA alone.
