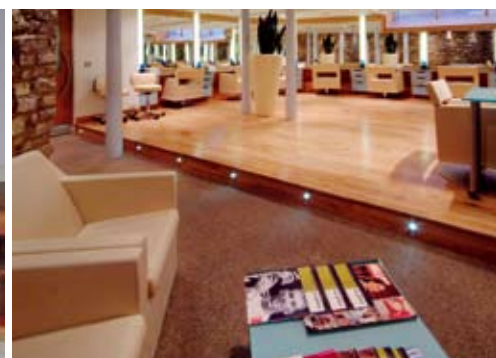


Spa 1877, Victoria Street Sheffield



The old Turkish Baths in Victoria Street, Sheffield were being refurbished and converted into a prestige Health and Beauty Spa.

The owners decided to retain as much as possible of the historic building's appearance, particularly the Victorian structure with internal stone, brick and timber finishes. To do this they also insisted on the use of high quality natural materials throughout the project.

They needed a new and durable, waterproof, non-slip yet attractive and easily cleaned floor, to blend in seamlessly with their natural and 'holistic' design concept. The floor should also have a 'natural' content and appearance
