Description

Until the completion of the Commerzbank Tower in 1997, the Messeturm (Exhibition Tower) was the highest office building in Europe. Its remarkable height of 256.5 metres makes the Messeturm in the West End a Frankfurt landmark. The building's striking structure of base, tower and spire is reminiscent of the American high-rise architecture of the 1920s.

Problem

After almost 20 years, the concrete façade showed considerable damage and was to be permanently protected.
