Description

De Ceuster Meststoffen is a family-run company and a European market leader in the field of organic and organic/mineral-based fertilisers. Since the company's philosophy of sustainability extends beyond just its product range, it constructed a new head office in the Belgian city of Grobbendonk. The brief: not simply ultra-modern, but also fit for the future.

Problem

Generous amounts of wood were integrated into the new DCM company headquarters in Grobbendonk. The timber surfaces were designed to merge seamlessly into the building's interior and protect the fittings from wear and tear. For this reason, natural effect varnishes were used in order to preserve the natural appearance of the wood while providing excellent resistance to scratches.

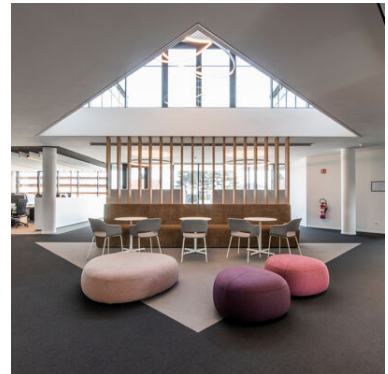

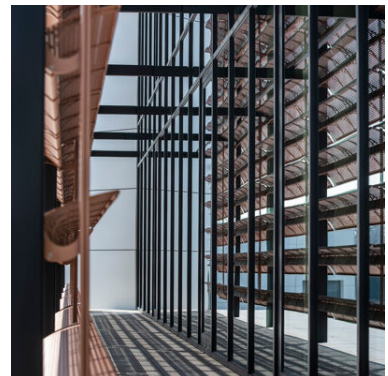

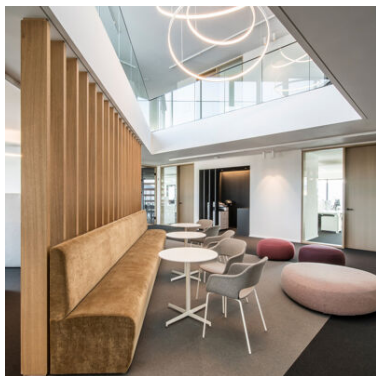
